



# The National Flu Immunisation Programme 2019/20

The surgery will be doing the over 65's flu jabs on Saturday 14th September - phone to arrange your appointment.

Under 65's at risk are not due until the 2nd week of October so clinics will be advertised in September.

The following are eligible for flu vaccination:

- > all children aged two to ten (but not eleven years or older) on 31 August 2019
- those aged six months to under 65 years in clinical risk groups
- pregnant women
- those aged 65 years and over
- those in long-stay residential care homes
- Unpaid carers
- > carers
